Must haves –

1. One spool of .015 or .018 gauge wire
2. Color coordinated beads (2-3 strands)
3. Filler beads in either gold, silver, or copper
4. Finishing clasp in the same metallic color
5. Crimp beads in the same metallic color (these must be new)
6. Bring either a bead board or a placemat to work on your necklace
7. Bring tools if you have them. We do have some to share.

2. Estate sales, garage sales, thrift stores
3. The Indian Store, Vons Shopping Center, El Norte Parkway
4. Jo-Ann Fabrics, East Valley Parkway
